





Åsgard Staff Programme

Norway - France

The "Asgard Staff Programme" is a project booster financed by the Research Council of Norway and the Department for scientific cooperation of the French Embassy in Norway. It aims at inviting French and Norwegian administrative staff working at universities, research centres and funding agencies for a one-week visit respectively to Norway or to France. During their stay, they will be given the opportunity to meet their counterparts and visit private and public research institutions.

Objectives

- .. **Develop exchanges** between actors of research administration from Norway and France;
- :. Encourage the emergence of cooperation projects;
- .. Support the exchange of good practices.

Application and selection

The "Asgard Staff Programme" is open to all professionals working in research and administration centres / scientific administration centres.

- .: A call for applications is launched every year in the autumn. Check our website for updates.
- .. Applications must be addressed to the Department for Scientific Cooperation of the French Embassy in Norway, before deadline, according to modalities mentioned in the call for applications.
- .. The evaluation and selection process are carried out during the week following the application deadlines.

Organization of visits

The successful applicants are invited for a **one-week visit** to France or to Norway, date being agreed with them. The programme of the visit is established by the successful applicant. The Department for scientific cooperation at the French institute can assist, if needed, to establish contacts with the appropriate French or Norwegian cluster, research institutions and companies.
